I want to share with you a different way we will be working on our second book study of the year. So far I have coordinated and facilitated every aspect of the book study in class. This study, in order to prepare our students for the more rigorous challenge of self-regulation that is required in the coming years, will be a truly independent book study.

#### What does this mean?

All work on the book study will be done at home. There will be no chapter tests or final exam. Instead students will work at their own pace working up to a final due date when all aspects must be turned in. I of course will not be leaving them completely on their own. You will find attached a schedule of completion that they can choose to follow or they can work ahead of that schedule.

#### How does it work?

I will provide the students with the first packet and when they complete that packet they bring it back and receive the next packet, and so on until they have completed all 12 packets. There will be a final project to this study. I have attached the menu of options for the final project here so that you are able to see exactly what will be expected.

### What if my child needs help?
